

Precinct Membership Stats Updated as of April 28, 2022

Excerpt from By-Laws:

(1) Precinct Representation:

- (a) One member for each precinct; and
- (b) An optional, additional member for each precinct for each 200 votes or major fraction thereof cast for the Republican candidates for President of the United States and Governor of the Commonwealth (combined) in the last preceding elections for such offices not to exceed the limits established by the Committee for each precinct prior to the advertisement of the mass meeting or RPV approved process held in even-numbered years;

Excerpts from By-Laws:

- (1) At-Large Membership: In addition to precinct representation, members may be elected to the Committee as at-large members in an amount not exceeding 30% of the total precinct membership; and

Total membership = 67 30% of Total membership = 20 voters

(2) Elected Officials: Elected Republican officials who are qualified voters of Culpeper County will be additional members of the Committee and will not be considered as at-large members.

Constitutionally Elected Officials [Delegates, Town Council, BOS, Sheriff, Treasurer, CA] do not count against the precinct tallies [Nick Freitas, Paul Walther, Joe Short, Janie Schmidt, Missy White]. School Board members are included [Deborah Desilets].
