



## MARK YOUR BALLOT NOW!

Early voting and absentee voting can be beneficial for folks who can't get to vote on election day and can increase participation by as much as 86%. Every Republican vote is needed to make a difference. This election is particularly consequential as it will determine party control of the currently divided Legislature for the final 2 years of Gov. Youngkin's term. Early voting and absentee voting began on September 22nd. More than 400 of Culpeper's 32,000 registered voters have cast their vote already and 300 or more have been by mail. Early voting continues through Nov 4<sup>th</sup> and the last day to request an absentee ballot is October 27<sup>th</sup>. Early voting takes place at the Voter Registration and Election Office located at 131 North Main Street. Absentee ballot must be postmarked by Election Day and received by noon 3 days after the election in order to be counted. It can also be returned in person to your local registrar's office or to a secure ballot drop box by 7pm on Election Day.
